The DDGT program lab is also an Autodesk Authorized Training Center, which ensures that students are always taught on the most current releases of the various Autodesk software programs used in their coursework.

As a graduate in digital design and graphics, you'll be ready to start your career in mechanical or architectural drafting and design or technical illustration using 3D rendering programs. Upon successful completion of the DDGT degree, students will receive five Autodesk software certifications.
