DDGT121 – Family Photos

Bring in a minimum of 6 family photos to be scanned for you to fix and repair. Here are things to consider:

- Yes, you must bring in physical pictures. Pictures you have taken with a digital camera have already been digitized and you will not have the errors present that I want to teach you how to fix.
- You should bring in at least 6 – 12 pictures that have issues that need to be repaired. You will not need to fix all of the images. I will choose which ones you will need to fix. Every student will be assigned a different number of images to repair based on the mistakes present in each image.
- At least one of the images should be black and white. If you do not have a black and white photo, you can make it one in Photoshop.
- At least one of the images should be color.
- All images should be at least 2x3" in size.
- Not all the images need to include people.
- There should be obvious mistakes in the image that need to be repaired. Do not bring in perfect pictures.
- If you cannot find any, ask a family friend. It should not be hard to find pictures to have repaired. People pay others for this; I am sure you can find someone who would love for you to fix an image of theirs for free.
- If you have your own scanner and wish to scan the images yourself, please scan them at a resolution of 600ppi. Otherwise, you can use the scanner in the classroom.
